Day One July 17 Start 12:30 Saint Etienne	Saint Arcons Auvergne	Train Station. Bus transfer to Saint Arcons (1.5 hours). Bikers: 31.5 km / 19.5 mile warm up loop ride. Non-riders: Afternoon of paragliding. Fly through the Massif Central with in a tandem jump with expert instructor.	Dinner included.
Day Two July 18	Saint Arcons Auvergne	TDF Finish Viewing: Final Route Pending Bikers: Optional morning ride before tour stage viewing. Following tour viewing, early afternoon loop in the wake of the tour 57.6 km / 35.7 miles Non-riders: Guided morning hike to local farm for goats cheese tasting. Early afternoon transfer to see TDF finish. .	Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner included.

Day Five July 21	Montagnole French Alps	TDF Alpes d'Huez Stage Viewing: Final Route Pending Helicopter transfer to see the dramatic finish on Alpes d'Huez. Following the finish, cable car transfer to nearby Vaujany for dinner and then late-night coach transfer back to Montagnole. .	Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner
Day Six July 22	Montagnole French Alps	Riders: Optional 90 km / 55.8 mile ride from Grenoble to Alpes d'Huez to conquer the famous climb.
